






• In Latvia you can find a large number of foreign language speaking people.

- Latvia has the fastest internet in Europe.






LOCATION

- Riga International Airport is one of the most modern airports in Europe.
- The airport is only 15 km from Jurmala city center and 10 km of the Riga city center.
- Connection with more than 3,000 cities all over the world.
- There are direct flights to Riga from more than 90 cities in Europe.
- AirBaltic, Aeroflot, Belavia, Finnair, LOT, Lufthansa, Norwegian, Ryanair, Ruslines, SAS, Turkish Airlines, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Wizz Air.
- Ferry connection to Riga is available from Stockholm.
- Train connections to Riga are available from Moscow, St. Petersburg, Vilnius, Minsk, Kiev.

- Today, Jūrmala's 26-kilometre-long beach has 11 Jūrmala's historical stages and gardens have delighted audiences with open-air concerts for over a century.
- A third of the city's area is forested, the beach is hidden behind a belt of pine-covered dunes.









Jurmala was formed by uniting several older fishing villages & swimming settlements.

1730 The first swimming guests arrived in Kaugurciems

1812 The development of the swimming industry in Kaugurciems was halted due to the war between Russia and France (the spa was subsequently relocated nearer to Riga, in Dubulti)

1818 The first chemical analysis of the waters was performed

1834 The so-called Dīveļa (Duevel) Hotel was built in Dubulti

1838 Baltic Governor-General von der Pahlen ecure state financing and land for the construction of a rehabilitation resort (official founding of the Kemeri spa)

1840 Summer concerts had been taking place in Dubulti

1870 concerts began in Majori as well, at Horn's Concert Garden





HISTORY

1877 Transportation system was developed, in particular by a railway

1914 First World War passed through Kemeri, and the spa was entirely destroyed

1936 New Kemeri spa hotel is built.

1945 Following the Second World War, a number of sanatoriums hosting guests year round were built.

1977–1982 Sanatorium Rīgas Jūrmala construction (Architec Viktors Valgums; Normunds Pavārs; Modris Ģelzis)

2003 Hotel Baltic Beach was re-opened

2004 Hotel Baltic Beach & SPA




